

LIBRARY LIMITED ACCESS POLICY

The primary responsibility of the Law Library is to support the teaching and research functions of the UCLA School of Law and other University of California (UC) researchers who need to use legal materials; therefore, access to the UCLA Law Library is restricted to Authorized Users.

Authorized users include: UCLA law students, UC faculty and staff, UC law school alumni, members in good standing of a state bar association, and a limited number of UCLA non-law students.
