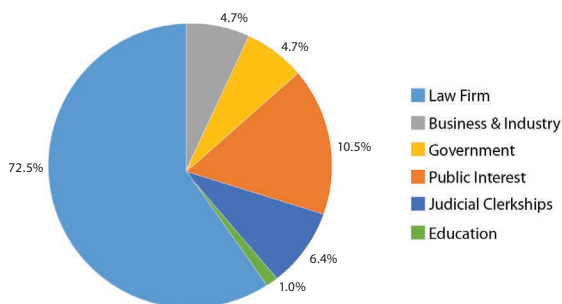

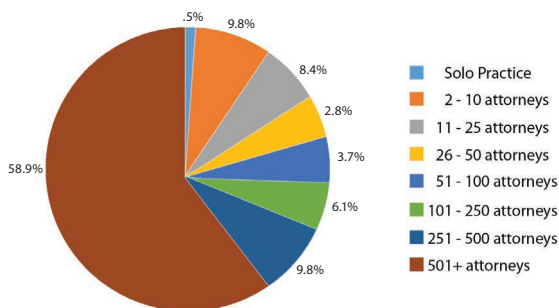
## EMPLOYMENT
