

IFLC – DACA Requirements & Evidence Checklist

*note this is a suggested list of what you would want to submit at a minimum

| DACA Requirements | Evidence |
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| <p>You must prove:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You arrived in the United States before age 16. 2. You have continuously resided in the United States from June 15, 2007 to present. 3. You were in the United States on June 15, 2012. 4. You were under the age of 31 on June 15, 2012. | <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Birth certificate • 2 passport style photos • Copies of ALL passports – Valid and Expired • Copies of ALL consular ID cards – Valid and Expired • Copies of ALL school IDs – Valid and Expired • Any other official photo ID • Complete school records (preferably cumulative transcripts) • Medical records (including vaccination records) • Employment records (including tax returns) • Other records (rent; utility; cell phone; sports or academic club; union; church, including baptism, communion, or confirmation) • Social media posting with date and location information <p>• <i>If missing proof for any dates:</i> Notarized letters declaring that you have been present in the United States from 06/15/2007 to present</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Declaration from yourself/parents/pastors/employers <p>If you have children:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certified copy of birth certificates • Proof of lawful immigration status of your children <p>If you have an immigration history:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lawful entry documents (visa, I-94 card, border crossing card) • Immigration applications filed • Removal proceedings documents from DHS and EOIR • Results of any background check <p>If you have left the United States since 06/15/2007:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Travel documents • Documents justifying and explaining your absences |
| <p>You must also prove that you are in school, graduated from high school, have a GED, or have been honorably discharged from the military.</p> | <p>Examples:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diploma • GED certificate • Report cards (every semester/quarter) • School transcripts (every semester/quarter) |
| <p>You have not been convicted of a felony, significant misdemeanor, or three or more other misdemeanors and do not otherwise pose a threat to national security or public safety.</p> | <p>If you have ever been arrested:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You almost always have to disclose this information, but we recommend speaking to the clinic about where you need to disclose the information and what documents you should submit. |
