Help create a country where obtaining abortion care is a right and care is delivered as essential basic, mainstream pregnancy care a person can access easily and affordably regardless of where they live or who they are without any barriers imposed by politicians.

Protect and expand affordable and confidential access to contraception for those most vulnerable to losing the right and access in this political environment (youth, low-income, uninsured people) and in ways that significantly shift the paradigms for access.

Help create a country with laws and policy supports that help people who decide to build families thrive in safe, healthy, nondiscriminatory, and economically supportive environments.

4

Inspire, engage, and train the next generation of advocates and ensure they learn *Dobbs* is wrong and have a reproductive justice frame on the work.

In early 2024, the CRHLP team filed an amicus brief on behalf of over 300 leading reproductive health researchers urging the Supreme Court to reverse a ruling that would severely restrict access to the abortion pill mifepristone.
