### **TUITION**

Average cost/tuition/semester: \$29,800\*

\* Assumes 13 units/semester. This is an estimate based on the tuition rate at \$2260/unit for 2021/2022. Additional \$900/semester in university fees. If a student does not have qualifying health insurance, campus provided Health Insurance is required @ \$2,360/semester. On campus housing potentially available for full-time students at an additional cost

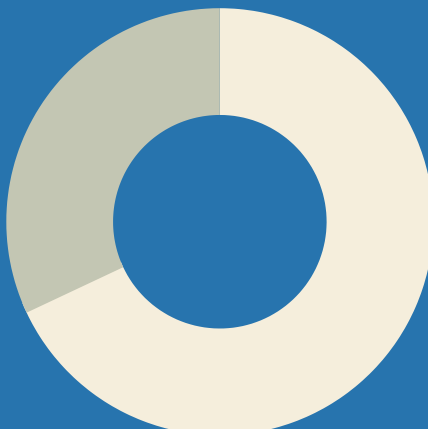
