# 22 SB 153 Insider Threats and Election Improvements

#### SB 153 Protections Against Insider Threats

- 1. Crime to tamper with voting system felony, two years, \$500K fine
- 2. Crime to "image" a voting system
- 3. Defines an "election record" to NOT include extraneous information
- 4. Elected officials in counties +100,000:
  - A. No keycard access to voting systems room
  - B. Never alone with a voting system
- 5. 24/7/365 Video surveillance and keyless entry:
  - A. \$1M funding for county grants
  - B. Enforced as of July 1, 2023

### SB 153 Election Improvements

- 1. Disqualifications for serving as a DEO:
  - A. Conviction of an election offense (Colorado or any U.S. jurisdiction)
  - B. Conviction of conspiracy to commit sedition, insurrection, or treason.
- 2. Certification Training for all county clerks and election officials
- 3. Misdemeanor to disobey an SOS order
- 4. Whistleblower protections to report a violation to law enforcement
- 5. When county fails to canvass:
  - A. SOS can certify an incomplete canvass
  - B. SOS can designate a special master to review and certify a canvass
- 6. Ballots must be tabulated on certified voting equipment

## 22 HB 1273 Protections for Election Officials

### HB 1273 Protections for Election Officials

- 1. Misdemeanor to Doxx an election official to intimidate or harass
- 2. Election Officials eligible to become "confidential voters"
- 3. Misdemeanor to interfere with an Election Official
  - A. Threats, intimidation or coercion while performing official duties
  - B. Threats, intimidation or coercion *in retaliation for* performing official duties.
